To be Voted Upon February 7, 2012

What is the County Development Tax?

- Frequently called the 'CDT Tax'
- Generates approximately \$1.6 million per year
- ½ Cent Sales Tax
 - \$0.05 per \$10 Spent
 - \$0.25 per \$50 Spent
 - \$0.50 per \$100 Spent

Is this a new tax?

- NO, it is an extension of an existing tax

Who pays this tax?

- Everyone who shops in Laclede County
- Best Part: Laclede County has a positive retail "pull factor" of 1.2, meaning approximately 17% of this tax is paid for by people living outside of Laclede County!
- Name all of the other taxes someone else helps us pay that is spent exclusively inside Laclede County!
