



INFORMATION FOR TUBERCULOSIS TESTING

In order to enter hospitals and clinics, students must complete a tuberculosis test **within 30 days of our August 15th start date.** You have the option of a one-time blood draw or taking 2 back-to-back skin tests. The blood draw is the most costly option. If you are interested in this, please contact your physician's office and insurance company for coverage information. If you do not have insurance or if this is not covered, you can contact:

If you would prefer the TB skin test, please remember that this is a two-step program. You would have the test, return 48 hours later to read the results, then wait at least 7 days, re-take the test and return in 48 hours to have the test read a second time.

I have not been successful at finding any labs or walk-in clinics in other communities who perform the blood draw test.
